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13 **WHEREAS** on August 24, 2018 Facility Association applied to the Board for approval of a
14 revised rating program for its Newfoundland and Labrador Public Bus class of business in
15 accordance with Order No. A.I. 25(2018); and
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17 **WHEREAS** on August 29, 2018 the Board’s actuarial consultants, Oliver Wyman Limited,
18 reported that the revised rating program complies with the parameters specified in Order No. A.I.
19 25(2018); and
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21 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are not too high in the circumstances.
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
24 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**
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- 26 1. The revised rating program received August 24, 2018 from Facility Association for its
27 Newfoundland and Labrador Public Bus class of business is approved to be effective no sooner
28 than February 1, 2019 for both new business and renewals.
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30 2. Facility Association will pay all costs of the Board, including the cost of the actuarial review,
31 arising from this Application.


