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16	WHEREAS on August 22, 2018 the Board's consulting actuaries, Oliver Wyman Limited
17	("Oliver Wyman"), filed a report (the "Oliver Wyman Report") of findings with the Board; and
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19	WHEREAS on August 29, 2018 S&Y Insurance Company filed comments in relation to the
20	Oliver Wyman Report; and
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22	WHEREAS on September 17, 2018 S&Y Insurance Company filed an amended rating program;
23	and
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25	WHEREAS on September 17, 2018 Oliver Wyman reported that the amended rating program
26	received September 17, 2018 proposed rate changes for each coverage that were the same or lower
27	than the rate indications presented in the Oliver Wyman Report; and
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29	WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are not too high in the circumstances.
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32	IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

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1. The revised rating program received August 2, 2018, amended September 17, 2018, from S&Y Insurance Company is approved to be effective no sooner than December 1, 2018 for new business and January 1, 2019 for renewals.

2. S&Y Insurance Company will be required to pay the costs of the Board associated with this filing, including the costs of the actuarial review.
