16	approved by the Board for certain coverages; and

8	WHEREAS on November 29, 2019 the Board's actuarial consultants, Oliver Wyman Limited
19	("Oliver Wyman"), filed a report ("Oliver Wyman Report") of findings with the Board which
20	identified key areas of the filing for the Board's consideration; and

22 23	WHEREAS on December 2, 2019 the Oliver Wyman Report was forwarded to Facility for
	comment; and

24 25 26	WHEREAS on December 12, 2019 Facility filed an amended rate application; and
27	WHEREAS on December 13, 2019 Oliver Wyman reported that the amended rate application
28	received from Facility on December 12, 2019 was consistent with prior Board decisions for
29	Facility rate applications for its Garage class of business; and

1 1	WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are not too high in the circumstances.

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The revised rating program received December 12, 2019 from Facility Association for its Garage class of business is approved to be effective no sooner than April 1, 2020 for new business and renewals.
