AN ORDER OF THE BOARD

1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Automobile*
2 *Insurance Act*, RSNL 1990, c. A-22 (the
3 “*Act*”), as amended and regulations
4 thereunder; and

6 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application
7 by Hartford Fire Insurance Company for
8 approval to implement a revised rating
9 program for its Commercial Vehicles
10 category of automobile insurance.

13 **WHEREAS** on July 17, 2020 Hartford Fire Insurance Company (“Hartford”) applied to the Board
14 for approval of a revised rating program under the IAO filing option for its Commercial Vehicles
15 category of automobile insurance; and
16

17 **WHEREAS** the IAO filing option may be used by insurers to adopt the most recent IAO rating
18 program accepted for use by the Board; and
19

20 **WHEREAS** the IAO filing option may also be used to introduce deviations to the IAO rating
21 program by insurers that are proposing to adopt or are currently using IAO rates; and
22

23 **WHEREAS** Hartford proposed to adopt the IAO rating program for Commercial Vehicles
24 accepted for use by the Board in Information Bulletin A.I. 2020-06 issued on May 5, 2020; and

26 **WHEREAS** Hartford did not propose any deviations to the IAO rating program; and

28 **WHEREAS** the revised rating program is filed in accordance with the IAO Filing Guidelines and
29 is supported; and

31 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the
32 circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the
33 financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the *Automobile Insurance Act* or the
34 *Insurance Companies Act* or the respective regulations thereunder.

1 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

1. The revised rating program received July 17, 2020 from Hartford Fire Insurance Company for its Commercial Vehicles category of automobile insurance is approved to be effective no sooner than September 1, 2020 for new business and renewals.
