1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the **Automobile**
2 **Insurance Act**, RSNL 1990, c. A-22,
3 as amended and regulations
4 thereunder; and

6 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application by
7 The Personal Insurance Company for
8 approval to implement rating program
9 changes for its Miscellaneous Vehicles
10 category of automobile insurance.

13 **WHEREAS** on August 10, 2023 The Personal Insurance Company (“The Personal”) applied to the
14 Board under the Supplemental filing option for approval of rating program changes applicable to
15 its Miscellaneous Vehicles category of automobile insurance; and
16

17 **WHEREAS** The Personal is transitioning to a new policy administration system and proposed
18 various rating program changes to assist in this migration; and
19

20 **WHEREAS** the proposed changes result in an overall rate level change of 0.0%; and

22 **WHEREAS** on September 6, 2023 the Board’s actuarial consultants, Oliver Wyman Limited, filed
23 a report of findings with the Board; and

25 **WHEREAS** Oliver Wyman noted the proposed changes were relatively minor or administrative in
26 nature and found them to be reasonable in the circumstances; and

28 **WHEREAS** the proposal is filed in accordance with the Supplemental Filing Guidelines; and


30 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the proposed changes are just and reasonable in the
31 circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the
32 financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the **Automobile Insurance Act** or the
33 **Insurance Companies Act** or the respective regulations thereunder.

- 3 1. The proposal received August 10, 2023 from The Personal Insurance Company for its Private
4 Passenger Automobiles category of automobile insurance is approved to be effective no
5 sooner than October 16, 2023 for new business and January 15, 2024 for renewals.
