1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the **Automobile**  
2 **Insurance Act**, RSNL 1990, c. A-22,  
3 as amended and regulations  
4 thereunder; and

6 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application by  
7 Primum Insurance Company for  
8 approval to implement a revised rating  
9 program for its Motorcycles class of  
10 Miscellaneous Vehicles automobile  
11 insurance.

14 **WHEREAS** on September 29, 2023 Primum Insurance Company (“Primum”) applied to the  
15 Board for approval of a revised rating program under the Mandatory Simplified filing option for  
16 its Motorcycles class of Miscellaneous Vehicles automobile insurance; and

18 **WHEREAS** Primum filed an overall rate level indication of +8% and proposed an overall rate  
19 level change of 0%; and  
20

21 **WHEREAS** Primum acknowledged that it lacked sufficient credible loss experience to consider  
22 the full magnitude of its filed rate level indications and that maintaining its current rates would  
23 benefit insureds; and

25 **WHEREAS** the revised rating program is filed in accordance with the Mandatory Simplified Filing  
26 Guidelines; and


28 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the  
29 circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the  
30 financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the **Automobile Insurance Act** or the  
31 **Insurance Companies Act** or the respective regulations thereunder.

1 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

- 3 1. The revised rating program received September 29, 2023 from Primum Insurance Company  
4 for its Motorcycles class of Miscellaneous Vehicles automobile insurance is approved to be  
5 effective no sooner than February 1, 2024 for new business and renewals.
