18	WHEREAS the IAO filing option may be used by insurers to adopt the most recent IAO rating
19	program accepted for use by the Board; and

21	WHEREAS Sovereign does not have sufficient volume to justify a rating program based on
22	company-specific data; and

24	WHEREAS Sovereign proposed to adopt the IAO rating program for Private Passenger
25	Automobiles accepted for use by the Board in Information Bulletin A.I. 2024-03; and

27	WHEREAS Sovereign also proposed the following changes:

29	<ul> <li>deviations to a number of deductibles;</li> </ul>
30	<ul> <li>to reclassify its distracted driving conviction from a minor to a major conviction;</li> </ul>
31	<ul> <li>to adopt the 2024 CLEAR rate group table; and</li> </ul>
32	<ul> <li>to maintain its current by-value rate group table; and</li> </ul>

WHEREAS the proposed rating program results in an overall rate level change of -7.7%; and
