17	WHEREAS NGIC proposed to introduce rates for a subset of Commercial and Interurban Vehicles
18	called Transportation and Logistic ("T&L") Vehicles which are primarily used for long-distance
19	heavy cargo transport; and

21	WHEREAS the proposal is part of a country-wide initiative with T&L rates having already been
22	implemented in Ontario, Alberta, Quebec and New Brunswick, and filings pending in Nova Scotia
23	and PEI; and

25	WHEREAS the proposed T&L rates were based on an internal analysis using Atlantic data and
26	the rate level impact was off-balanced to be 0% overall to achieve revenue neutrality; and
