17	Motorized Snow Vehicles and Motorhomes; and

19	WHEREAS the IAO filing option may be used by insurers to adopt the most recent IAO rating
20	program accepted for use by the Board; and

22	WHEREAS Federated does not have sufficient volume to justify a rating program based on
23	company-specific data; and

25	WHEREAS Federated proposed to adopt the IAO rating program for Miscellaneous Vehicles
26	accepted for use by the Board in information bulletin A.I. 2024-04; and

28	WHEREAS Federated also proposed the following changes:
29	<ul> <li>adopt the 2024 CLEAR rate group table for Motorcycles;</li> </ul>
30	rating rule adjustments;
31	surcharge adjustments; and
32	<ul> <li>changes to endorsement pricing: and</li> </ul>

WHEREAS Federated has no exposures and the proposed rating program results in an overall rate
