IN THE MATTER OF the Automobile 1 2 Insurance Act, RSNL 1990, c. A-22, 3 as amended and regulations 4 thereunder; and 5 6 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application by 7 Protective Insurance Company for 8 approval to implement a revised rating 9 program for its Commercial Vehicles 10 category of automobile insurance. 11 12 13 WHEREAS on November 25, 2024 Protective Insurance Company ("Protective") applied to the 14 Board for approval of a revised rating program under the IAO filing option for its Commercial 15 Vehicles category of automobile insurance; and 16 17 WHEREAS the IAO filing option may be used by insurers to adopt the most recent IAO rating 18 program accepted for use by the Board; and 19 20 WHEREAS Protective proposed to adopt the IAO rating program for Commercial Vehicles 21 accepted for use by the Board in information bulletin A.I. 2024-03; and 22 23 WHEREAS Protective has no Commercial Vehicles exposures and thus does not have sufficient 24 volume to justify a rating program based on company specific data; and 25 26 WHEREAS the proposed rating program results in an overall rate level change of -3.8%; and 27 28 WHEREAS the revised rating program is filed in accordance with the IAO Filing Guidelines; and 29 30 WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the 31 circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the 32 financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the Automobile Insurance Act or the 33 Insurance Companies Act or the respective regulations thereunder.

1 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

- 3 1. The revised rating program received November 25, 2024 from Protective Insurance Company
- 4 for its Commercial Vehicles category of automobile insurance is approved to be effective no
- 5 sooner than March 1, 2025 for new business and renewals.
