21	WHEREAS Security National proposed an overall rate level change of 16.67%, which included the
22	following rating program changes:
23	 Base rate changes by coverage;
24	 Rate group table updates;

WHEREAS Security National also proposed to implement rate capping provisions for renewal

WHEREAS the revised rating program is filed in accordance with the Mandatory Simplified Filing
