AN ORDER OF THE BOARD

NO. A.I. 23(2025)

IN THE MATTER OF the **Automobile Insurance Act**, RSNL 1990, c. A-22, as amended and regulations thereunder; and

IN THE MATTER OF an application by Co-operators General Insurance Company for approval to introduce endorsements for its Motorcycles and Mopeds type of Miscellaneous Vehicles automobile insurance.

WHEREAS on March 7, 2025 Co-operators General Insurance Company (“Co-operators”) applied to the Board under the Supplemental filing option for approval to introduce endorsements for its Motorcycles and Mopeds type of Miscellaneous Vehicles automobile insurance; and

WHEREAS Co-operators proposed to offer two new optional endorsements for Motorcycles and Mopeds, to enhance its product offering and better meet the needs of insureds; and

WHEREAS there is no rate level impact associated with this change; and

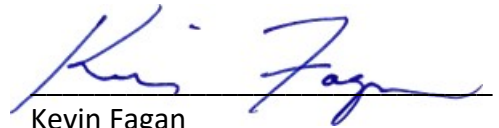
WHEREAS the proposal is filed in accordance with the Supplemental Filing Guidelines; and

WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed changes are just and reasonable in the circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the **Automobile Insurance Act** or the **Insurance Companies Act** or the respective regulations thereunder.

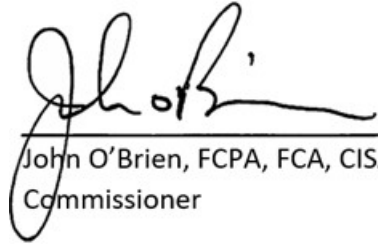
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The proposal received March 7, 2025 from Co-operators General Insurance Company to introduce endorsements for its Motorcycles and Mopeds type of Miscellaneous Vehicles automobile insurance is approved to be effective no sooner than September 3, 2025 for new business and October 3, 2025 for renewals.
