20	in an overall average rate level change of -5.0%; and
21	WHEREAS the rate filing was forwarded to the Board's actuarial consultants, Oliver Wyman
22	Limited ("Oliver Wyman") for review; and
23	Limited (Oliver wyman) for review, and
24	WHEREAS on January 7, 2025 Oliver Wyman reported that it found all of TD Home and Auto's
25	proposed changes to be reasonable from an actuarial standpoint; and

27	WHEREAS the proposal is filed in accordance with the Supplemental Filing Guidelines; and
