WHEREAS on October 18, 2024 the Board issued A.I. 56(2024) to Belair Insurance Company Inc.
 ("Belair") approving an overall rate level change of +8.5% for its Private Passenger Automobiles

- 15 category of automobile insurance effective November 3, 2024 for new business and January 3,
- 16 2025 for renewals; and

WHEREAS during post-implementation testing, Belair identified an issue with the rate group mapping used in its indication which resulted in some vehicles being assigned lower rate groups

- 20 than intended when the rating program changes were implemented; and

- WHEREAS the rate group mapping issue resulted in Belair implementing an overall rate levelchange of +7.5% rather than the +8.5% approved by the Board; and

- WHEREAS on January 28, 2025 Belair proposed base rate changes by coverage to address the
  rate group mapping issue and align its overall rate level change with the +8.5% approved by the
  Board; and

- WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed changes are appropriate to bring the ratingprogram in compliance with A.I. 56(2024); and

WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the **Automobile Insurance Act** or the

35 **Insurance Companies Act** or the respective regulations thereunder.
