A-22, 3 as amended and regulations 4 thereunder; and 5 6 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application by 7 Belair Insurance Company Inc. for 8 approval to implement a revised rating 9 program for its Trailers and Camper Units 10 category of automobile insurance. 11 12 13 WHEREAS on November 28, 2024 Belair Insurance Company Inc. ("Belair") applied to the Board 14 for approval of a revised rating program under the Mandatory Simplified filing option for its 15 Trailers and Camper Units category of automobile insurance; and 16 17 WHEREAS Belair proposed changes to the application of its Group Discount, as well as base rate 18 changes by coverage, resulting in an overall rate level change of 0%; and 19 20 WHEREAS the revised rating program is filed in accordance with the Mandatory Simplified Filing 21 Guidelines; and 22 23 WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the 24 circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the 25 financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the Automobile Insurance Act or the 26 Insurance Companies Act or the respective regulations thereunder. 27 28 29 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:** 30 31 1. The revised rating program received November 28, 2024 from Belair Insurance Company Inc. 32 for its Trailers and Camper Units category of automobile insurance is approved to be effective 33 no sooner than May 2, 2025 for new business and July 1, 2025 for renewals.
