AN ORDER OF THE BOARD

NO. A.I. 46(2026)

IN THE MATTER OF the **Automobile Insurance Act**, RSNL 1990, c. A-22, as amended and regulations thereunder; and

IN THE MATTER OF an application by Security National Insurance Company for approval to implement rating program changes for its Private Passenger Automobiles, Miscellaneous Vehicles and Commercial Vehicles categories of automobile insurance.

WHEREAS on August 7, 2026 Security National Insurance Company (“Security National”) applied to the Board under the Supplemental filing option for approval of rating program changes applicable to its Private Passenger Automobiles, Miscellaneous Vehicles and Commercial Vehicles categories of automobile insurance; and

WHEREAS Security National proposed to introduce two serious convictions relating to the Alcohol Ignition Interlock Program; and

WHEREAS Security National clarified the treatment of two existing convictions; and

WHEREAS Security National proposed other various editorial and formatting changes; and

WHEREAS there is no rate level impact associated with this proposal; and

WHEREAS the proposal is filed in accordance with the Supplemental Filing Guidelines; and

WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the proposed rates are just and reasonable in the circumstances, do not impair the solvency of the insurer, are not excessive in relation to the financial circumstances of the insurer, and do not violate the **Automobile Insurance Act** or the **Insurance Companies Act** or the respective regulations thereunder.

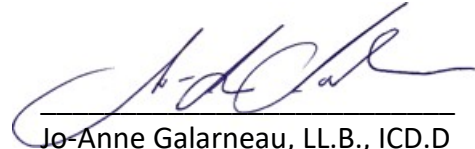
1 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

6 business and December 14, 2026 for renewals.

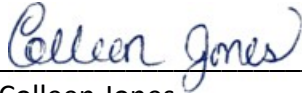
