7 of maximum price adjustments for
8 gasoline and diesel motor fuels and
9 stove oil heating fuel in Zones 10, 11
10 and 11b.
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13 **WHEREAS** Order No. P.P. 51(2021) suspended maximum price adjustments for gasoline and
14 diesel motor fuels and stove oil heating fuel in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11b, 12 and 14, effective
15 November 25, 2021; and
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
17 **WHEREAS** based on delivery information provided to the Board by suppliers to the region the
18 spring resupply of gasoline and diesel motor fuels and stove oil heating fuel to Zones 10, 11 and
19 11b has commenced; and
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21 **WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the seasonal suspension of maximum price adjustments
22 should be lifted for gasoline and diesel motor fuels and stove oil heating fuel in Zones 10, 11 and
23 11b.
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26 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT**
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- 28 1. The suspension of maximum price adjustments for gasoline and diesel motor fuels and
29 stove oil heating fuel implemented pursuant to Order No. P.P. 51(2021) is lifted in Zones
30 10, 11 and 11b, effective 12:01 a.m. May 26, 2022.
