11 **WHEREAS** in Order No. P.P. 99(2022) the Board approved the lifting of the suspension of
12 maximum price adjustments, effective December 9, 2022, for gasoline and diesel motor fuels and
13 stove oil heating fuel in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11b, 12 and 14; and


15 **WHEREAS** delivery information provided by suppliers to the region confirms that the winter
16 resupply of gasoline and diesel motor fuels and stove oil heating fuel to Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11b,
17 12 and 14 has been completed and, as a result, the Board is satisfied that it is appropriate at this
18 time to address the suspension of maximum price adjustments in Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11b, 12 and
19 14 for the upcoming winter; and

21 **WHEREAS** based on the information provided the Board is satisfied that the seasonal suspension
22 of maximum price adjustments for gasoline and diesel motor fuels and stove oil heating fuel in
23 Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11b, 12 and 14 should be implemented until resupply of product in the spring.



- 28 1. Maximum price adjustments for gasoline and diesel motor fuels and stove oil heating fuel in
29 Zones 10, 11, 11a, 11b, 12 and 14 shall be suspended as of the scheduled maximum price
30 adjustment effective 12:01 a.m. January 5, 2023, until further order of the Board.
