AN ORDER OF THE BOARD

NO. P.P. 138(2026)

IN THE MATTER OF the **Petroleum
Products Act**, SNL 2001, Chapter P-10.1
and Regulations thereunder; and

IN THE MATTER OF the retail maximum
price for full-serve regular gasoline motor
fuel chargeable by Black Tickle Convenience
and Gas Inc. in Zone 11a - Coastal Labrador
South.

WHEREAS Order No. P.P. 113(2026) approved a retail maximum price that could be charged by
Black Tickle Convenience and Gas Inc. ("BTCG") in Zone 11a - Coastal Labrador South of 206.3
cents per litre for full-serve regular gasoline, inclusive of applicable taxation, effective July 29,
2026, until further order of the Board; and

WHEREAS on August 26, 2026 BTCG advised the Board that it had received deliveries of
gasoline motor fuel on August 22, 2026 and provided volumetric and delivery information with
respect to the petroleum product at BTCG's retail location; and

WHEREAS based on its review of the cost, volumetric and delivery information provided by
BTCG with respect to gasoline motor fuel the Board is satisfied that an adjustment to maximum
retail prices for BTCG in Zone 11a - Coastal Labrador South is warranted to reflect the costs of
resupply; and

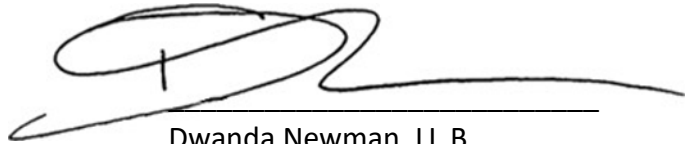
WHEREAS the Board finds that a retail maximum price for full-serve regular gasoline motor fuel
of up to 216.2 cents per litre, including applicable taxes, should be established for BTCG in Zone
11a - Coastal Labrador South.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

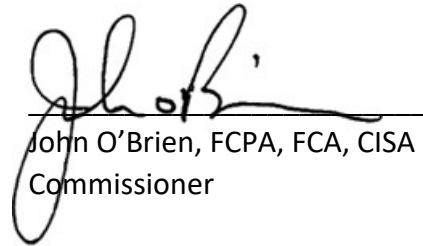
1. Black Tickle Convenience and Gas Inc. can charge a retail maximum price of up to 216.2
cents per litre, taxes included, for full-serve regular gasoline motor fuel in Zone 11a -

- 2 order of the Board.

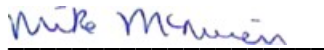
