AN ORDER OF THE BOARD

NO. P.P. 156(2026)

IN THE MATTER OF the **Petroleum Products**
Act, SNL 2001, Chapter P-10.1 and
Regulations thereunder; and

IN THE MATTER OF the retail maximum
price for stove oil heating fuel chargeable
by Black Tickle Convenience and Gas Inc.
in Zone 11a - Coastal Labrador South.

WHEREAS Order No. P.P. 83(2026) approved a retail maximum price that could be charged by
Black Tickle Convenience and Gas Inc. ("BTCG") in Zone 11a - Coastal Labrador South of 148.46
cents per litre for stove oil heating fuel, exclusive of applicable taxation, effective June 18,
2026, until further order of the Board; and

WHEREAS on September 23, 2026 BTCG advised the Board that it had received a delivery of
stove oil heating fuel on September 21, 2026 and provided cost, volumetric and delivery
information; and

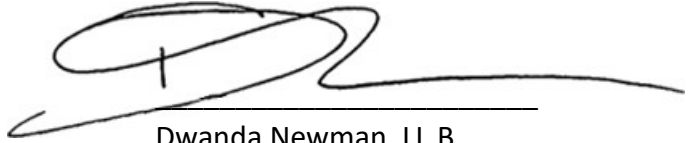
WHEREAS based on its review of the cost, volumetric and delivery information provided by
BTCG with respect to stove oil heating fuel the Board is satisfied that an adjustment to the
maximum retail price for BTCG in Zone 11a - Coastal Labrador South is warranted to reflect the
cost of resupply; and

WHEREAS the Board finds that a retail maximum price for stove oil heating fuel of up to 182.31
cents per litre, excluding applicable taxes, should be established for BTCG in Zone 11a - Coastal
Labrador South.

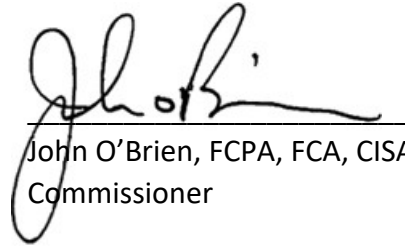
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. Black Tickle Convenience and Gas Inc. can charge a retail maximum price of up to 182.31
cents per litre, taxes excluded, for stove oil heating fuel in Zone 11a - Coastal Labrador
South, effective 12:01 a.m. Friday, September 25, 2026, until further order of the Board.

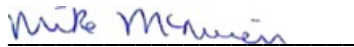
