WHEREAS by Order No. P.U. 31 (2005) the Board approved the Applicant's proposed 2006 capital 1 2 expenditures in the amount of \$42,636,000; and 3 WHEREAS by Order No. P.U. 10 (2006) the Board approved an additional amount of capital 4 5 spending by the Applicant of \$183,800 for the replacement of a failed diesel engine at Hydro's diesel generating plant at Charlottetown; and 6 7 WHEREAS by Application dated March 31, 2006, the Applicant applied to the Board pursuant to 8 9 section 41(3) of the Act, seeking approval of additional 2006 capital expenditures totaling \$174,000 for the purchase of approximately 12.7 acres of land adjacent to the Hardwoods Terminal Station 10 located in Paradise upon which land the Applicant has four high voltage (230 kV) transmission lines; 11 12 and 13 14 WHEREAS the Applicant provided as a Schedule to the application a capital proposal explanation for this land acquisition and also attached a report from a land appraiser to determine the fair value 15 for the acquisition of the land; and 16 17 18 WHEREAS the Board has considered the application, including the explanations contained in Schedule A and the appraisal report, and is satisfied that the proposed expenditure is prudent and 19 20 necessary in order to provide reasonably safe and adequate and just and reasonable service as 21 required by the *Act*. 22
