**AN ORDER OF THE BOARD**

1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Electrical Power*  
2 *Control Act, 1994*, SNL 1994, Chapter E-5.1  
3 (the “*EPCA*”) and the *Public Utilities Act*, RSNL  
4 1990, Chapter P-47 (the “*Act*”), as amended,  
5 and regulations thereunder; and  
6

7 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application by  
8 Newfoundland Power Inc. for approval of a  
9 Contribution in Aid of Construction for a line  
10 extension to serve domestic customers residing  
11 in the cottage area near the community of  
12 Winterbrook pursuant to section 41 of the *Act*.

15 **WHEREAS** Newfoundland Power Inc. (“Newfoundland Power”) is a corporation duly  
16 organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a public  
17 utility within the meaning of the *Act*, and is also subject to the provisions of the *EPCA*; and  
18

19 **WHEREAS** on July 4, 2014 Newfoundland Power filed an application for approval of a  
20 Contribution in Aid of Construction (“CIAC”) for a single-phase line extension of approximately  
21 1,593 metres (the “Extension”) to serve Domestic Customers in a cottage area near the  
22 community of Winterbrook ; and

24 **WHEREAS** two potential customers of the area (the “Customers”) have requested that  
25 Newfoundland Power provide electrical service; and  
26

27 **WHEREAS** the Customers have requested the Refundable CIAC Option provided for in Clause  
28 5(a) of the CIAC Policy: Distribution Line Extensions to Domestic Customers approved by  
29 Order No. P.U. 27(2005) (the “Policy”); and  
30

31 **WHEREAS** the proposed CIAC for the Extension of twenty-five thousand five hundred twenty-  
32 three dollars and thirteen cents (\$25,523.13), excluding HST, has been calculated in accordance  
33 with the Policy; and  
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35 **WHEREAS** the sum of the CIAC calculated pursuant to Clause 5(a) and the Basic Investment  
36 calculated pursuant to Clause 3 is \$52,546.25 and Clause 10(i) of the Policy states that  
37 Newfoundland Power shall apply to the Board for approval of all CIACs where the sum of the  
38 CIAC calculated pursuant to Clause 5(a) or Clause 6(a) and the Basic and Additional Investment  
39 calculated pursuant to Clauses 3 and 4 is greater than \$50,000; and

1 **WHEREAS** the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that Newfoundland Power's investment  
2 in the Extension is compensatory over the useful life of the Extension and will not be to the  
3 detriment of Newfoundland Power's other customers.  
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5  
6 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**  
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- 8 1. The Refundable Contribution in Aid of Construction of twenty-five thousand five  
9 hundred twenty-three dollars and thirteen cents (\$25,523.13), excluding HST, to apply to  
10 Domestic Customers located in the cottage area near the community of Winterbrook is  
11 approved.

13 2. Newfoundland Power shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.


