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15	WHEREAS Newfoundland Power Inc. ("Newfoundland Power") is a corporation duly
16	organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a
17	public utility within the meaning of the Act, and is also subject to the provisions of the EPCA:

IN THE MATTER OF the Electrical Power

and

WHEREAS on August 23, 2017 Newfoundland Power filed an application for approval of a Contribution in Aid of Construction ("CIAC") to upgrade the three-phase service provided to Husky Energy Inc.'s graving dock at Argentia by upgrading the size of the conductors on 3.8 kilometers of an existing three-phase line and installing 3 new three-phase voltage regulators and a three-phase metering tank; and

WHEREAS the application states that the upgrade is required to serve an increased electrical load associated with the planned construction of a concrete gravity structure for the White Rose Extension offshore oil project; and

WHEREAS the CIAC, calculated in accordance with Clause 5(e) of the CIAC Policy: Distribution Line Extensions and Upgrades to General Service Customers approved by Order No. P.U. 27(2005) (the "Policy"), is two hundred and forty nine thousand four hundred and ninety eight dollars and eighty cents (\$249,498.80), excluding HST; and

WHEREAS Clause 10(ii) of the Policy states that the company shall apply to the Board for approval of all line extensions or upgrades involving CIACs where the cost of the line extension or upgrade is calculated pursuant to Clause 5(e); and

WHEREAS the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that Newfoundland Power's investment is compensatory over the useful life of the upgrade and will not be to the detriment of its other customers.

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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

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1. The Contribution in Aid of Construction of two hundred and forty nine thousand four hundred and ninety eight dollars and eighty cents (\$249,498.80), excluding HST, to upgrade the three-phase service to Husky Energy Inc.'s graving dock in Argentia is approved.

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2. Newfoundland Power shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.
