AN ORDER OF THE BOARD

1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Electrical Power*
2 *Control Act, 1994*, SNL 1994, Chapter E-5.1 (the
3 “*EPCA*”) and the *Public Utilities Act*, RSNL
4 1990, Chapter P-47 (the “*Act*”), as amended,
5 and regulations thereunder; and

7 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application by
8 Newfoundland Power Inc. for approval of a
9 Contribution in Aid of Construction to provide
10 three-phase service to a lift station on Indian
11 Pond Drive in the Town of Conception Bay South,
12 pursuant to section 41 of the *Act*.

15 **WHEREAS** Newfoundland Power Inc. (“Newfoundland Power”) is a corporation duly
16 organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a
17 public utility within the meaning of the *Act*, and is also subject to the provisions of the *EPCA*;

20 **WHEREAS** on November 14, 2017 Newfoundland Power filed an application for approval of
21 a Contribution in Aid of Construction (“CIAC”) to provide three-phase service to a lift station
22 on Indian Pond Drive in the Town of Conception Bay South by upgrading 860 metres of
23 single-phase line to three-phase standard; and
24

25 **WHEREAS** the CIAC, calculated in accordance with Clause 5(e) of the CIAC Policy:
26 Distribution Line Extensions and Upgrades to General Service Customers approved by Order
27 No. P.U. 27(2005) (the “Policy”), is one hundred and fourteen thousand five hundred and
28 eighty two dollars and sixty one cents (\$114,582.61), excluding HST; and

30 **WHEREAS** Clause 10(ii) of the Policy states that the company shall apply to the Board for
31 approval of all line extensions or upgrades involving CIACs where the cost of the line
32 extension or upgrade is calculated pursuant to Clause 5(e); and

34 **WHEREAS** the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that Newfoundland Power’s investment
35 is compensatory over the useful life of the upgrade and will not be to the detriment of its other
36 customers.


1 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

- 3 1. The Contribution in Aid of Construction of one hundred and fourteen thousand five hundred
- 4 and eighty two dollars and sixty one cents (\$114,582.61), excluding HST, to provide three-
- 5 phase service to a lift station on Indian Pond Drive in the Town of Conception Bay South is
- 6 approved.

- 8 2. Newfoundland Power shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.
