1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Electrical Power*  
2 *Control Act, 1994*, SNL 1994, Chapter E-5.1  
3 (the “*EPCA*”) and the *Public Utilities Act*, RSNL  
4 1990, Chapter P-47 (the “*Act*”), as amended,  
5 and regulations thereunder; and

7 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application by  
8 Newfoundland Power Inc. for approval of  
9 a Contribution in Aid of Construction for  
10 a single-phase extension to the Indian Cove  
11 Cottage Area, pursuant to section 41 of the *Act*.

14 **WHEREAS** Newfoundland Power Inc. (“Newfoundland Power”) is a corporation duly  
15 organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a public  
16 utility within the meaning of the *Act*, and is also subject to the provisions of the *EPCA*; and

18 **WHEREAS** on June 1, 2018 Newfoundland Power filed an application for approval of a  
19 Contribution in Aid of Construction (“CIAC”) for a single-phase extension of approximately  
20 1,493 metres (the “Extension”) to serve Domestic Customers located in a cottage area known as  
21 Indian Cove located at Ritters Arm, Cottrells Cove/Fortune Harbour Highway; and  
22

23 **WHEREAS** the CIAC, calculated in accordance with Clause 5(a) of the CIAC Policy:  
24 Distribution Line Extensions to Domestic Customers approved by Order No. P.U. 27(2005) (the  
25 “Policy”) is fourteen thousand two hundred thirty five dollars and twenty five cents  
26 (\$14,235.25), excluding HST; and

28 **WHEREAS** Clause 10(i) of the Policy states all line extensions or upgrades involving CIACs  
29 where the costs calculated pursuant to Clause 5(a) are estimated to be greater than \$50,000  
30 require approval of the Board; and  
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32 **WHEREAS** the sum of the CIAC calculated pursuant to Clause 5(a) and the Basic Investment  
33 calculated pursuant to Clause 3 is \$60,641.00; and  
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35 **WHEREAS** the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that Newfoundland Power’s investment  
36 in the Extension is compensatory over the useful life of the Extension and will not be to the  
37 detriment of its other customers.

1 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

- 3 1. The Refundable Contribution in Aid of Construction of fourteen thousand two hundred  
4 thirty five dollars and twenty five cents (\$14,235.25), excluding HST, to apply to Domestic  
5 Customers located in a cottage area known as Indian Cove located at Ritters Arm, Cottrells  
6 Cove/Fortune Harbour Highway, is approved.  
7  
8 2. Newfoundland Power Inc. shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this  
9 Application.
