AN ORDER OF THE BOARD

1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Electrical Power*
2 *Control Act, 1994*, SNL 1994, Chapter E-5.1
3 (the “*EPCA*”) and the *Public Utilities Act*,
4 RSNL 1990, Chapter P-47 (the “*Act*”), as
5 amended, and regulations thereunder; and

7 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application by
8 Newfoundland Power Inc. for approval of a
9 Contribution in Aid of Construction for a line
10 extension to provide three-phase service to
11 Newco Metal and Auto Recycling Limited,
12 pursuant to section 41 of the *Act*.

15 **WHEREAS** Newfoundland Power Inc. (“Newfoundland Power”) is a corporation duly
16 organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a
17 public utility within the meaning of the *Act*, and is also subject to the provisions of the *EPCA*;

20 **WHEREAS** on August 30, 2018 Newfoundland Power filed an application for approval of a
21 Contribution in Aid of Construction (“CIAC”) to provide three-phase service to a metal
22 processing facility operated by Newco Metal and Auto Recycling Limited, located on
23 Incinerator Road, near Foxtrap in Conception Bay South by constructing a 65 metre three-
24 phase line extension and upgrading a 6.4 kilometre three-phase line; and

26 **WHEREAS** the CIAC, calculated in accordance with Clause 5(e) of the CIAC Policy:
27 Distribution Line Extensions and Upgrades to General Service Customers approved by Order
28 No. P.U. 27(2005) (the “Policy”), is two hundred and sixty-seven thousand and forty-five
29 dollars and fifteen cents (\$267,045.15), excluding HST; and

31 **WHEREAS** Clause 10(ii) of the Policy states that the company shall apply to the Board for
32 approval of all line extensions or upgrades involving CIACs where the cost of the line
33 extension or upgrade is calculated pursuant to Clause 5(e); and

35 **WHEREAS** the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that Newfoundland Power’s investment
36 is compensatory over the useful life of the upgrade and will not be to the detriment of its other
37 customers.


1 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

- 3 1. The Contribution in Aid of Construction of two hundred and sixty-seven thousand and
4 forty-five dollars and fifteen cents (\$267,045.15), excluding HST, to provide three-phase
5 service to a metal processing facility operated by Newco Metal and Auto Recycling
6 Limited is approved.

- 8 2. Newfoundland Power shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.


