AN ORDER OF THE BOARD

1 **IN THE MATTER OF** the *Electrical Power*
2 *Control Act, 1994*, SNL 1994, Chapter E-5.1
3 (the “*EPCA*”) and the *Public Utilities Act*,
4 RSNL 1990, Chapter P-47 (the “*Act*”), as
5 amended, and regulations thereunder; and

7 **IN THE MATTER OF** an application by
8 Newfoundland Power Inc. for approval of a
9 Contribution in Aid of Construction for a line
10 extension to provide single-phase service to
11 Destination RV Resort Inc., pursuant to
12 section 41 of the *Act*.
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15 **WHEREAS** Newfoundland Power Inc. (“Newfoundland Power”) is a corporation duly
16 organized and existing under the laws of the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, is a
17 public utility within the meaning of the *Act*, and is also subject to the provisions of the *EPCA*;

20 **WHEREAS** on November 19, 2018 Newfoundland Power filed an application for approval of
21 a Contribution in Aid of Construction (“CIAC”) to provide single-phase service to a
22 recreational vehicle park operated by Destination RV Resort Inc. (the “Customer”), located off
23 the Trans-Canada Highway, west of Salmonier Line, by constructing a 2,158 metre single-
24 phase line extension to an existing line for which another customer paid a CIAC approved by
25 the Board in Order No. P.U. 4(2016); and
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27 **WHEREAS** Clause 5(c) of the CIAC Policy: Distribution Line Extensions and Upgrades to
28 General Service Customers approved by Order No. P.U. 27(2005) (the “Policy”) requires that
29 the CIAC be calculated as if service was connected to the customer when the existing line was
30 originally placed in service; and
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32 **WHEREAS** the CIAC, calculated in accordance with Clause 5(a) of the Policy, including the
33 CIAC to be paid by the Customer in respect of the existing line and calculated in accordance
34 with Clause 5(c) of the Policy, is one hundred and five thousand four hundred and sixty-eight
35 dollars (\$105,468.00), excluding HST; and
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
37 **WHEREAS** Clause 10(i) of the Policy states that the company shall apply to the Board for
38 approval of all line extensions or upgrades involving CIACs where the construction costs are
39 estimated to be greater than \$50,000; and

1 **WHEREAS** the proposed CIAC is necessary to ensure that Newfoundland Power's investment
2 is compensatory over the useful life of the upgrade and will not be to the detriment of its other
3 customers.

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6 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**
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- 8 1. The Contribution in Aid of Construction of one hundred and five thousand four hundred
9 and sixty-eight dollars (\$105,468.00), excluding HST, to provide single-phase service to a
10 recreational vehicle park operated by Destination RV Resort Inc. is approved.
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12 2. Newfoundland Power shall pay all expenses of the Board arising from this Application.


