

Q. At page 7 Newfoundland Power states:

“Chart 6 compares the Canadian utility survey results for the kilometers driven at which vehicles are assessed or replaced for each class of vehicle to Newfoundland Power’s criterion.”

At page 9 Newfoundland Power states:

“Chart 8 compares the Atlantic Canadian regional utility survey results for the kilometers driven at which vehicles are assessed or replaced for each class of vehicle to Newfoundland Power’s criterion.”
