9		Would it be reasonable for the Board to consider recovery of NP's 2016 costs in the

12	A.	Deferring the filing of Newfoundland Power's general rate application ("GRA") from
13		June 1, 2015 to September 1, 2015 would not, in Newfoundland Power's view, be
14		consistent with regulatory efficiency.
15		consistent with regulatory environely.
16		If Newfoundland Power were to file a GRA by September, 2015 with a 2016 test year, it
17		is likely that, given the current schedule for Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro's
18		("Hydro") amended GRA, that the conclusion of Newfoundland Power's GRA could still
19		not occur until late 2016 or early 2017. For this reason, the 2016 deferred cost recovery
20		proposed in the Application is the superior alternative to addressing the current
21		circumstances.
