## Deviations from the trend line that exceed 5%

1. Transmission: Variance is due primarily to increased operating labour for transmission inspections, maintenance and vegetation management activity.

2. Administrative & Engineering: Variance is due primarily to normal labour inflation as operating labour costs represent two thirds of total costs in this category. Other factors include an increased overtime and centralized scheduling and dispatch of work. The benefits of the centralized scheduling and dispatch are outlined in detail in Section 3.3.3: Operations Outlook, Pages 3-19 to 3-21.

3. Environment: Variance is due primarily to normal labour inflation as operating labour costs represents approximately 68% of the total costs in this category.
