- Q. Reference: Dr. Booth Evidence, Page 37, Lines 18-20: Has Dr. Booth ever
- 2 utilized a different beta coefficient in any evidence he has submitted in the past ten
- 3 years for a regulated gas or electric utility company? If so, please specify.

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- 5 A. Uncertain as Dr. Booth does not track his recommendations from previous cases.
- 6 However, he has used a range of 0.45-0.55 at least since the financial crisis and his 2009
- 7 evidence. In his view the risk of Canadian utilities has not changed very much due to the
- 8 significant amount of regulatory protection they are afforded.
