Re: Hydro 2017 General Rate Application Second Round RFI responses

With respect to Hydro's filing of responses to the second round Requests for Information of the parties, we request leave of the Board to file follow up Requests for Information in relation to Hydro's response to IC-NLH-146.

Specifically, we refer to Hydro's "Reason for Omission", at page 2 of 2 the IC-NLH-146 response, in relation to two Come By Chance 2016 expenditures, that "*at the time Hydro's response to IC-NLH-015 was filed in 2014, specific bushings for replacement were not identified*" and "....specific protected devices for replacement were not identified".

As appears from Hydro's response to IC-NLH-008 in the 2016 Capital Budget Application (copy enclosed), these expenditures were not identified as specifically assigned in that capital budget process.

The capital expenditures in question, as apparently identified in Table 2 to IC-NLH-103, total \$0.7 million.

Hydro's response to IC-NLH-146, in the context of the above, leaves remaining questions as to whether and how the capital expenditures in question were identified as being specifically assigned and approved, in any capital budget process before the Board.

We trust this request is in order. If formal application or motion needs to be made to make further requests for information in this regard, please advise.
