5	A.	300 MW is an approximation of the technical limit of the capacity that can be
6		delivered to Newfoundland over the Maritime Link.
7		
8		The exact transfer limit is defined at Woodbine Terminal Station at the Nova Scotia
9		terminus of the Maritime Link. The transfer limit is specified to be 325 MW, which
10		comes from the Loss of Load Criteria for the Maritime Area. This limit reflects the
11		maximum block of load that can be shed in the Area while adhering to system
12		interchange limits with New England. Transmission of 325 MW from Woodbine
13		Terminal Station in Nova Scotia equates to 310 MW delivered at Bottom Brook
14		Terminal Station in Newfoundland.
