Q. 1 (Reference response to CA-NLH-40) Is it correct to say that CBPP will be able to avail 2 of Hydro's transmission, but will not be allowed to use the transmission to purchase 3 electricity to supply its own needs, or to sell its generation to other island customers? Is it accurate to say that CBPP has open access to the transmission 4 5 system, but does not have the right to use the transmission system? If this is not 6 the case, please provide examples of how CBPP might actually use the transmission 7 system; i.e., could CBPP sell its generation outside the Province? 8 9 10 Pursuant to section 14.1 of the Electrical Power Control Act, 1994, SNL 1994, Α. 11 Chapter E-5.1 (EPCA), Corner Brook Pulp and Paper (CBPP) is not permitted to 12 purchase electricity from suppliers other than Hydro to supply its own needs, or to 13 sell its generation to other Island Industrial Customers or Newfoundland Power. 14 CBPP may apply to the Newfoundland and Labrador System Operator (NLSO) to use 15 the transmission system to sell power or energy it generates to entities outside the 16 Island portion of the Province.
