8	Α.	The transmission facilities on the Island that are included as part of the Maritime
9		Link that Nalcor will be allowed to use without incurring a transmission charge are:
10		the HVdc converter station in Bottom Brook Terminal Station #2; the overhead dc
11		line from the converter station to Cape Ray; and the electrode line from the Bottom
12		Brook converter station to Indian Head. These transmission facilities are owned by
13		Emera.
