Please explain in detail what Hydro means when it says, "the conclusion 4 of the existing RSP adjustments". 5 6 7 On July 1, 2018 the Rate Stabilization Plan (RSP) Mitigation Adjustment approved by 8 A. 9 the Board in Order No. P.U. 16(2017) will expire. This will result in increased billings to Newfoundland Power of approximately \$53 million however; these additional 10 billings will flow to the RSP and will not contribute towards recovery of Hydro's 11 2018 revenue requirement. 12
