3		Please provide the information in Tables 8 and 9 for the Expected Supply Scenario
4		based on a forecast fuel price 20% greater, and alternatively 20% lower, than the
5		fall 2017 fuel price update.

8	A.	To respond to the question would require Hydro to complete four additional cost of
9		service studies (two for each Test Year) and compute customer rate impacts for
10		each. Hydro has complied with the Board's direction on providing additional
11		information to enable the comparison of the customer rate impacts under the
12		Revised Deferral Account Scenario and the Expected Supply Scenario. Therefore,
13		Hydro considers the provision of the requested information to be unduly onerous,
14		and the additional information requested is not required for the Board to evaluate
15		which Test Year revenue requirement approach is preferred.
