Q. Does Hydro have enough resources to meet the 2018/19 winter demand at adequate levels of reliability? Please provide the latest demand/supply report for the 2018/19 winter on the Island system.

6 Hydro filed the Reliability and Resource Adequacy report with the Board on A. 7 November 16, 2018. This report included the latest demand/supply information for 8 the 2018-2019 winter on the Island Interconnected System. As stated in the report 9 "The results indicate increased exposure through the 2018-2019 winter season for 10 Holyrood unavailability in excess of 15 percent and in the case of the unavailability of the LIL<sup>1</sup> through the operating season. This risk is mitigated to within existing 11 planning criteria when the proposed incremental capacity assistance is included in 12 the analysis."<sup>2</sup> Applications for approval of capacity assistance arrangements were 13 approved for agreements with Corner Brook Pulp and Paper<sup>3</sup> and Vale<sup>4</sup>. These 14 agreements mitigate the risk to within existing planning criteria. Hydro is therefore 15 confident in the resource availability to meet the 2018-2019 forecasted demand at 16 adequate levels of reliability. 17
