11		Please refer to Hydro's response to PUB-NLH-94. Neither Hydro nor Concentric
12		Advisors are aware of the precise date of conversion to ELG procedure of the listed
13		utilities, as a number of the utilities converted to ELG from as far back as the 1980's
14		As such, references to the regulatory decisions are not available.
15		
16		However as noted in the Concentric Depreciation Study at page I-3, Newfoundland
17		Power received Board approval for new plant additions in a 1978 General Rate
18		Application. Following a 1982 General Rate Application the Board accepted that
19		ELG rates would be used for all plants, and since 1983, the ELG has been in place for
20		Newfoundland Power.
