7	A.	This response has been provided by Concentric Advisors (Concentric).
8		
9		Concentric views that the plateau data at age 40 is based on exposures comprising
10		approximately of 15% of the age 0 exposures and that the only retirement after age
11		40 is \$16,000, of a total retirement of \$1,900,000. Concentric views that fitting an
12		lowa curve to the last observed data point is inappropriate and results in a lower
13		ordered Iowa curve combined with a longer life. Furthermore, Concentric has
14		considered the total observed data plateau as the recommended Iowa 65-R4 does
15		dissect the plateau at approximately its midpoint. In addition, Concentric views the
16		Iowa 65-R4 as more appropriate based on the historical data, peer review and on
17		Concentric's experience.
