23		Industrial Customers' rates. In accordance with OC2013-343, these costs will be	
24		recovered through Island Interconnected rates. Order in Council OC2013-343 states	
25		that:	
26		Any expe	nditures, payments or compensation paid directly or
27		indirectly	by Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro, under an
28		agreeme	nt or arrangement to which the Muskrat Falls Project
29		Exemptio	on Order applies shall be included as costs, expenses or

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1	allowances, without disallowance, reduction or alteration of those
2	amounts, in Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro's cost of service
3	calculation in any rate application and rate setting process, so that
4	those costs, expenses or allowances shall be recovered in full by
5	Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro in Island interconnected rates
5	charged to the appropriate classes of ratepayers [emphasis
