10	Response:	Some work was completed on three of the items identified in the audit, namely:

12 13		 Leak survey of compressed air lines: the survey was completed and air leaks were addressed,
14		 Piping insulation: insulation was added in some places, and
15		 Pump efficiency program: IOC added a number of high efficiency pumps.
16		
17		Considering the de minimis impact on IOC's consumption and limitation on the
18		metering and monitoring at the lower voltage distribution levels, the energy savings
19		are not measurable.
20		
21		In contrast, since 2010, IOC expanded and added additional capacity, in the range of
22		30 to 35 MW that thwart the impact of energy efficiency measures.
