13		Application, please refer to Hydro's response to PUB-NLH-003.

15		(ii) Hydro plans to file its Cost of Service Methodology application in the third
16		quarter of 2018 with a projected end date, including an order of the Board, of
17		March 2019. <sup>1</sup>
18		
19		(iii) and (iv) Hydro plans to file its 2019 GRA, which will include recovery of Muskrat
20		Falls Project costs, by June 30, 2019 with the requirement for new customer rates
21		projected to be in effect September 1, 2020.

23		Hydro notes that the process schedule for each proceeding will ultimately be
24		determined by the Board.
