- A. The increase in labour cost for Information & Operations Technology (IT/OT) was primarily due to an increase in FTEs. The business justification for these changes is driven by the need for corporate reorganization to ensure organizational independence for Hydro, while enhancing organizational effectiveness and
- minimizing intercompany transactions for Engineering Services. Previously, these
- 14 FTEs resided in Nalcor and provided services to Hydro.
