9	A.	This response has been provided by Concentric Advisors (Concentric).
10		
11		To the knowledge of Concentric, currently Manitoba Hydro and SaskPower follow a
12		practice of charging removal costs for the existing asset to the installation costs of
13		the replacement asset when the replacement asset is in the same location.
14		Additionally, Concentric notes that with the introduction of International Finance
15		Reporting Standards (IFRS) 14, a number of Canadian utilities are reviewing their
16		net salvage treatment.
