1	Q.	Further to the response to Request for Information IC-NLH-122:
2		
3		Attachment 1 is a copy of Nalcor Energy's June 23, 2017 project update for the
4		Muskrat Falls project. At Page 20 of 26, there are Island Interconnected Domestic
5		Rate Projections.
6		
7		However, the Provincial Government has indicated it plans to keep rates at par with
8		the forecast Atlantic Canada average of 17 cents per kilowatt-hour.
9		
10		How, in Hydro's view, should the Board consider this evidence in the context of
11		these Government pronouncements when evaluating the proposed Off-Island
12		Purchases Deferral Account?
13		
14		
15	A.	Hydro considers the proposed Off-Island Purchases Deferral Account to be one
16		component of a number of rate mitigation initiatives that will be required to limit
17		the required increase in customer rates.
