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3 JT Browne evidence indicates that *“the current Government has indicated that*
4 *export sales will be used to mitigate potential increases in electricity rates, thereby*
5 *reducing the above increases. Even if this is the case, it is expected that rates will be*
6 *significantly higher than what they would otherwise be, at least for the foreseeable*
7 *future.”*

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9 Please provide all data supporting Mr. Browne’s claim that, even if export sales
10 were used to mitigate potential increases in electricity rates, rates will be
11 significantly higher than they would otherwise be. This data should include all
12 assumptions relating to (i) forecast export sales revenue, and (ii) forecast customer
13 rates.
