Please explain why Hydro chose to base its cost-benefit analysis of the Business Systems

Transformation Program on only the two scenarios indicated.

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Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro based its cost-benefit analysis on the two scenarios provided in the "Business Systems Transformation Program Justification Report" to demonstrate the reasonability and prudence of Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro's participation in the shared services Business System Transformation Program. It did not consider other scenarios based on alternate software or vendor options as the intent of the cost-benefit analysis was not to select software or vendors; rather, it was to determine the minimum operating and maintenance savings necessary for the implementation of the new systems to be more economical than continuing with the previous systems.
