

1 Q. Did Hydro purchase energy from Non-Utility Generators at times when it was
2 spilling water in 2016? If so, please provide a table showing (i) when such
3 purchases occurred, (ii) the amounts of energy purchased during the period of each
4 purchase, and (iii) the cost of each purchase.

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7 A. Hydro purchased energy from Non-Utility Generators in every month of 2016. The
8 total energy purchased for the months during which there was spill is summarized
9 in Table 1.
