Rate mitigation suggestions

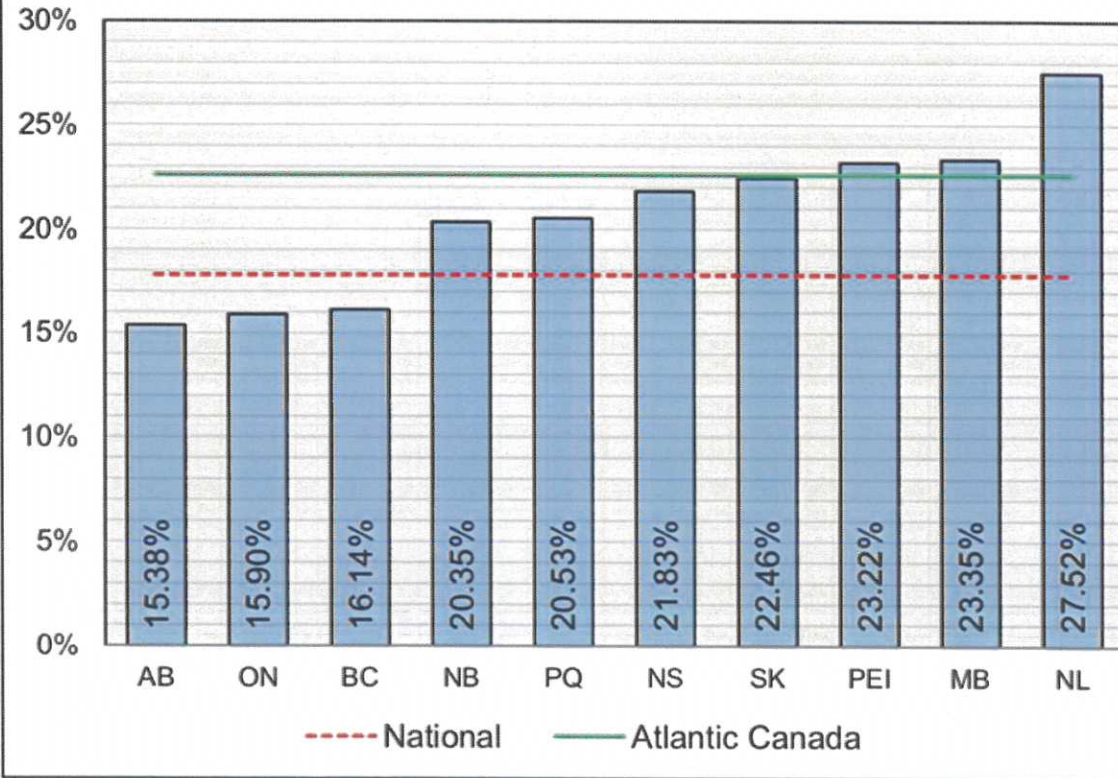
- Cut public sector to that of the national average and save upwards of \$1.8 billion/year
